

Who is entitled to use a eurokey?

People who are dependent on the use of special facilities (wheelchair users, ostomy wearers, people with a visual disability, a walking disability or chronic incontinence problems)

Eurokeys are given directly to the user and **not** to institutions, temporary carers etc. Only one key per person is provided.
